Informed Acceptance of Dentures at Wax Try-In

What is a wax try-in? A wax try-in is a preliminary viewing of your denture with the individual teeth set in a gum-colored wax. It is used by you and the dentist to evaluate and achieve the desired appearance of your denture before it is processed in our lab.

Why is this step so important? The wax try-in step is the point at which any changes to the appearance of the teeth can be made. Once the wax try-in has been approved by you, the final denture will be processed (completed) directly from the wax denture. The completed denture **cannot** be adjusted for **appearance** again. It is very important that you are satisfied with the appearance of the denture at the wax try-in appointment. This wax try-in “denture” will not fit or feel like a real denture as it is only intended to evaluate the bite and appearance of the final denture.

What is our office policy? We encourage you to take your time and address any questions at the wax try-in appointment(s) to ensure satisfactory results. We recommend that a family member or friend accompany you to help evaluate the wax try-in. Once you have approved the look of the wax denture try-in in your mouth we will then process your denture in our lab. **We cannot change or remake your denture after processing** due to any dissatisfaction with the **appearance** of the denture without an additional fee being charged.

I have evaluated the denture's appearance at the wax try-in stage and I am completely satisfied with all of the following...

1. Color of denture teeth (shade is not too light or too dark)
2. Size and arrangement of the denture teeth (width and length is not too big or small)
3. Amount the denture teeth show when I smile (the teeth don't show too much or too little)
4. Fullness of lip support (lip is not too full or too sunken)
5. Overlap of the front teeth (upper and lower teeth bite together the way I like)

I approve of the appearance of the denture at the wax try-in stage, and understand that the appearance will be the same in the completed/final denture. I understand that additional fees will be charged for any changes or adjustments to the appearance of the final denture and I will not be entitled to any refund of the original fee after approving the appearance of the wax try-in.
